To whom it may concern,

The fabrics (including mesh) used in cubicle curtains and window treatments sold by Medline Industries, Inc pass NFPA #701 (Fire Tests for Flame Propagation of Textiles and films). This test satisfies the requirements of NFPA 101 Life Safety Code sections 21.7.5 and 10.3.1. The fabrics pass NFPA #701 after 5 launderings (AATCC 96 Commercial IV C).

The curtains are not considered obstructions to sprinkler heads according to NFPA 13, 8.6.5.2.2.1. The mesh is more than 70% open and is a minimum of 20 inches in width on all curtains.

Shower curtains sold by Medline Industries, Inc meet ASTM 0568 as self extinguishing.
